(COVID-19)



Due to the severity of COVID-19 pandemic, Mahamakut Buddhist University, Mahapajapati Buddhist College is aware of the safety in life of our officers and students who may get impact from the disease therefore launching the formal regulations for prevention as followings:

1. Lecturers, officers, and students must wear a mask and use alcohol gel every time when staying both inside and outside of the college. Before going outside and after coming back, please sign your names, inform your destination, and record your going-out and coming-back time. The recorded paper is placed at the college office.
2. Lecturers and officers, who are necessary to travel to other provinces, please ask for the travel permission from the director. For the students, please inform your guardian before travelling and be able to travel after get permission from the lecturers only.
3. Lecturers, officers, and students who return from other provinces, the followings are your management rules:
 - 3.1 Lecturers, officers, and students, travelling to the other provinces by your private transportation both out-going and in-coming, do not need the 14-day quarantine.
 - 3.2 Lecturers, officers, and students, travelling to the other provinces by public transportation both out-going and in-coming, need the 14-day quarantine after coming back to the college.
 - 3.3 In case that lecturers, officers, and students travel from or to the red zones or the surveillance area as the government announcement both out-going and in-coming, must take the 14-day quarantine without any condition. (Both taking your private or public transportation)
4. For the 1st semester of academic year 2021, the 1st -4th year students who are staying in the college dormitory, please coming back after May 20, 2021.
5. Lecturers, officers, and students, who break the above rules, will get punishment.

Effective from now on until further notice.
